I am very happy to inform you that, although there is still a lot of work to be done, we have once again managed to create or continue several important projects to help people with physical disabilities in the broadest sense of the word, including amputees.

Thanks to the Poland Business Run relay, which in 2019 covered 10 Polish cities and over 27 thousand runners, we have obtained funds to subsidise prosthetic limbs, rehabilitation and medical equipment. This kind of help is necessary for many people to start fighting for themselves and return to life before their accident or illness. But that is not all.

On special rehabilitation stays in the Rehabilitation Centre 'Znowu w Biegu' we taught people after amputation to walk on a prosthesis. Thanks to the State Street grant we started a project of professional activation for people with disabilities. We encouraged our charges to physical activity by organizing sports camps and integration trips.

We also continued to focus on prevention and education, drawing attention to the problems of our beneficiaries..

The heart grows when we realize how many wonderful people, institutions and companies have contributed to providing the best possible, comprehensive care for our charges.

On behalf of myself, the whole Poland Business Run team and the beneficiaries, I thank you for this year. I hope that we will meet in the next one with new energy and motivation to help further! Meanwhile, I would like to invite you to briefly return to the past months and read the report summarizing our activities.

Did you know that...

In 2018 there were **12 675** amputations performed in Poland. The number of procedures continues to grow.

Meanwhile, the prices of prostheses and medical equipment exceed the capabilities of most patients. A limb's prosthesis is an expense between **20,000** and even **400,000** PLN.* Wheelchairs cost between **1000** and **30,000** PLN.

*Prostheses are individual medical devices and their elements are selected depending on the patient's needs, as well as their health condition, activity, age, etc.

Poland Business Run 2019 Beneficiaries

In 2019, the Foundation received 196 applications for financial support.

Thanks to the funds raised, we were able to help 94 people with disabilities.

ON - professional activation project

It was to us who received the first in Poland High Impact Grant from State Street Foundation. The "Centre for Vocational Education for People with Disabilities" project assumes a number of activities for the years 2019-2021. The participants of the programme, under the constant care of trainers, career advisors and psychologists, will gain practical knowledge and learn the best ways of professional development.

So far, as part of the project, we have conducted training courses for corporate employees to prepare them to work in a team where the person with a disability is participating. We have also organized rehabilitation trainings, consultations with a career counsellor and integration trips for people with disabilities who want to return to the labour market. The next stages of the project will follow soon.

Co-operation with the 'Znowu w Biegu' Centre

For a year now, there has been a space in Kraków where our beneficiaries and all people with motor disabilities are being professionally rehabilitated, educated and return to fitness and life "on the run again". It is the only place in Poland, specializing in helping people after amputation.

In 2019, we decided to expand our activities to develop adapted sport in Poland. We established the Sports Initiatives Centre Foundation, which, in cooperation with Karcher Hall of the 100th anniversary of Cracovia Sports Centre for the Disabled, will organise a number of sporting events for ON.

Special parasports sections will be created, where people with disabilities will start their adventure with physical activity and healthy competition.

"Qualitative studies have confirmed that physical rehabilitation aimed at improving the physical fitness of the body is of particular importance for people with motor dysfunction. The representatives of this group are particularly exposed to the aggravation of ailments and deterioration of their health condition due to insufficient access to the recovery rehabilitation."
